Minor Waiver, Temporary Guardianship, and Pit Vehicle Information

CROW HILL MINOR WAIVER POLICY

All minors must have a minor release form signed by both parents! Per order of our insurance company, any minor riding open practice or racing at Crow Hill Motorsports Park, LLC **must have both the 2026 Minor Release signed and notarized by both parents AND the 2026 Minor Race Weekend Event Release signed and witnessed by both parents and the minor!** This applies to all minors at all events this year. The forms (**Form 2** and **Minor Race Weekend Release**) can be found on the Crow Hill website www.crowhillmoto.com.

If both parents are present at the track, they may sign the 2026 Minor Release and the 2026 Minor Race Weekend Release at the track, in the presence of a track official who will have to check IDs. If one parent will not be able to make it to the track, that parent must sign and have the forms notarized beforehand, and then the other parent can bring them to the track where the parent on site can sign them in front of a track official who will have to check an ID. There is a box on the 2026 Minor Release to initial for sole guardians.

If this is your first-time riding at Crow Hill, you must bring a photocopy of the minor's birth certificate for our file. All minors who bring the 2026 Minor Release forms properly signed and notarized will be given a card stating that we have the proper documents on file. You will not be allowed to sign up for a race without bringing this card to sign up. The card DOES NOT eliminate the need for at least one of the parents or guardians to be present at sign up for the minor.

CROW HILL TEMPORARY GUARDIAN POLICY

If your child will be attending and riding a practice or racing at Crow Hill Motorsports Park and some other adult will be bringing your child, both parents must sign and have notarized the Guardian Form (**Form 3**) appointing a legal (over 18) guardian for the day.

QXNE MINOR WAIVER POLICY

All QXNE Members under the age of 18 must have our Minor Waiver **signed by both parents/legal guardians** and the Minor Waiver **must be notarized**. This is required by our insurance in order to receive your membership and participate in QXNE races. We will have a notary on site at each race. **Must be done once per season.**

Parents/legal guardians that will not be present with their child to sign the Minor Waiver when picking up the child's membership card will have to **complete, sign, and have the Minor Waiver notarized beforehand**, and the minor must bring the completed/signed/notarized waiver to the track with them. The minor child's **original certified birth certificate** must also be presented, so QXNE officials can verify it and make a copy to keep on file with the Minor Waiver. Premade **photocopies** presented to QXNE officials **will not be accepted**. If QXNE has the birth certificate on file already from the past 2 years, you do not need to bring it again.

In the case that the minor child only has **one sole legal parent/guardian**, **LEGAL PROOF is required** (i.e. court paperwork, sole custody paperwork, adoption paperwork, a death certificate, etc.).

This Waiver is two pages! It must be printed double sided, in color, on white paper, signed by the minor child and by both legal parents/guardians, and be notarized (can be done at the track if both parents are present).

QXNE TEMPORARY GUARDIAN POLICY

The QXNE PARENTAL PERMISSION FOR GUARDIANSHIP OF MINOR form is for **MINOR MEMBERS** if a parent/legal guardian will not be attending the event.

The QXNE PARENTAL PERMISSION FOR GUARDIANSHIP OF MINOR form needs to be **completed by both parents and notarized** prior to coming to the track if a **parent is not attending the event with the minor**. This form allows the parent to appoint a guardian who can make medical decisions if necessary for the minor child, and allows the minor child to register as a QXNE Member and participate in member activities. PIT VEHICLE RULES

1. Pit vehicles (golf carts, mules, mini quads, etc.) may be used only IF the track allows said use. Every track is different and there is no guarantee pit vehicles will be permitted at any track. Pit vehicle privileges may be revoked or terminated for any reason or no reason at the discretion of QXNE or track officials.
2. In order to operate a pit vehicle at a QXNE event, you must be a licensed driver and possess a pit vehicle pass for that event. **NO ONE** without **BOTH** a valid driver's license and a pit vehicle pass may operate a pit vehicle. (handicap exceptions may apply at QXNE discretion)
3. To obtain a pit vehicle pass, you must present your valid driver's license to the designated QXNE staff member at sign-up and pay a \$5 pit vehicle fee.
4. **NO JOY RIDING TO KILL TIME!** Pit vehicles are to be used for getting to/from sign-up, mechanics to/from the track for motos, other necessary errands, etc.
5. Unauthorized pit vehicles may be confiscated for the remainder of the event.
6. Pit vehicle use is not allowed on Fridays. Pit vehicles may be used on Saturdays and Sundays only, when permitted by the track. Saturday curfew is 8 PM. See track staff for handicap exception.
7. 5 MPH speed limit for all pit vehicles.
8. Pit vehicles are prohibited on the racetrack or anywhere inside the racetrack area, except by authorized QXNE or track officials.
9. Passengers are only permitted on/in pit vehicles that are specifically designed to carry passengers. Manufacturers designated seating capacity may not be exceeded.
10. Pit vehicles may not be operated in a reckless, careless or dangerous manner, nor by anyone under the influence of intoxicants, drugs, or alcohol. All passengers must be seated during operation of the pit vehicles.
11. Helmets must be worn at all times by operators and passengers of any pit vehicle (golfcart type machines excluded unless required by the track).
12. Violators and associated members/riders/drivers of these pit vehicle rules and any other rules designated by the track may be subject to penalties, including but not limited to: loss of gate pick, being docked positions, loss of championship points, disqualification, removal, or ban from the event, and termination of QXNE membership.
